Powell Sworn in as Fifth Chief of Police for Hillsborough Township

Twenty-two Year Veteran of the Force Promoted

The Hillsborough Township Committee took the final step by swearing in Hillsborough Township Police Department's Acting Police Chief Darren Powell to the position of Chief of Police for the Township.

"Late last year, we appointed then Lieutenant Darren Powell to the position of Acting Police Chief and it is with honor that we swear him in today as Chief of Police of the Hillsborough Police Department," stated Mayor Frank DelCore.

Chief Powell joined the Hillsborough Police Department over 22 years ago as a Police Officer. He was appointed to Corporal in 1999, Sergeant in 2002 and Lieutenant in 2009. Chief Powell is also a graduate of the FBI National Academy (March 2014); it is a professional development course for both US and International law enforcement leaders.

Powell will succeed retiring Chief Paul Kaminsky after serving nearly 10 years of dedicated service as Police Chief for Hillsborough Township.

During the swearing in ceremony, Mayor DelCore noted reiterated that "it is with honor that the Township once again is able to promote from within to this prestigious position."

Powell was joined at the ceremony by his wife, Kathleen and one of his two daughters, Courtney. His daughter Amanda is away currently attending college.

“Chief Powell embodies the standard of excellence set by our Police Department through his outstanding leadership qualities and professional demeanor, which will continue to benefit our community,” concluded Mayor Frank DelCore.
