

Four Township Police Officers Awarded Medal of Valor

Sergeant David Fisher, Corporal Thomas McLain, Officer Stephen Nowacki, and Officer Andrew Chudy, Police Officers in the Hillsborough Township Police Department, were recognized at the June 14th Township Committee Meeting for their acts of heroism in responding to a fire in a multi-family residence on April 8th, 2016.



Sergeant Fisher, Corporal McLain, Officer Nowacki, and Officer Chudy quickly assessed the gravity of the situation and entered the burning building in order to alert any remaining residents of the fire. Upon hearing calls from the second floor, Sergeant Fisher reentered the building and guided two residents to safety. If it were not for the bravery and heroic actions of Sergeant Fisher, Corporal McLain, Officer Nowacki, and Officer Chudy, the outcome of the fire could have been much worse.
