Bus Service Comes to Hillsborough *Express Service to New York City Began Monday, October 17th*

Mayor Frank DelCore, Committeeman Doug Tomson and Committeeman Greg Burchette cut the ribbon for the new Suburban Transit Bus Service from Hillsborough to New York on Monday morning.

Commuters to New York City now have another option for their commute with Suburban Transit's Line-200, Hillsborough Service, Express to Grand Central Terminal and the United Nations.
