Peter J. Biondi (June 23, 1942 - November 10, 2011) served in the NJ State Assembly representing Legislative District 16 from 1998 until his passing in 2011.

Prior to serving in the Legislature, Assemblyman Biondi served the citizens of Somerset County as Committeeman and Mayor of Hillsborough, as a Freeholder and Director of the Somerset County Board of Chosen Freeholders.

He was actively involved in many important community organizations and served as an Advisor for the Samaritan Homeless Interim Program (SHIP).

Assemblyman Biondi is fondly remembered for his tireless advocacy on behalf of his constituents and for his desire to help those in need. The purpose of this trail run or walk is to recognize and honor Mr. Biondi's years of dedicated public service while raising awareness and proceeds for the marginalized individuals and families in the Somerset County region.
