### **Suraci, McCauley Chosen for Mayor and Deputy Mayor for Hillsborough Township for 2017**

Hillsborough Township Committee selected Carl Suraci as Mayor and Gloria McCauley as Deputy Mayor for 2017, at the annual reorganization meeting Tuesday evening.

Committeeman Frank DelCore, who was re-elected in November, was sworn in for a fourth three year term on the Township Committee.

Suraci brings extensive knowledge and experience to the position, beginning his 14<sup>th</sup> year on the Township Committee and having served as Mayor in 2006 and 2012, and Deputy Mayor in 2005 and 2011. Furthermore, during his tenure on the Committee, Suraci previously served as liaison to many boards and functional areas including the Board of Adjustment, Credit Card Advisory, Economic & Business Development, Emergency Management, Historic Preservation, Library, Personnel, Planning Board, Police, Recreation Commission, Rescue Squad and Sign Review Committee.

Following his swearing in by Assemblyman Jack Ciattarelli, Suraci thanked his family and colleagues for their continued support. He then recapped the 2016 highlights and provided an outlook for 2017, focusing on continued fiscal prudence in managing the Township's finances while monitoring the affordable housing requirements mandated by the State and looking forward to officially opening the Mountain View Park Complex.

“It is my honor to be given the opportunity to serve as Mayor for 2017,” commented newly selected Mayor Suraci.

“This Township Committee will continue to maintain a watchful eye over the fiscal operations of the Township,” added Mayor Suraci.

Deputy Mayor Gloria McCauley was also sworn in by Assemblyman Jack Ciattarelli.

“I am looking forward to supporting the Mayor this year and I promise to continue serving the public from what they expect from their local government,” commented Deputy Mayor McCauley.

The meeting concluded with the appointments to various Township Boards and Commissions for the year 2017 which was followed by light refreshments in the multi-purpose room.
