Skate Park at AVM Gets Renovated *Ribbon Cutting Friday, May 12th at 6 pm*

Deputy Mayor Gloria McCauley announced that this Friday, May 12th at 6 pm there will be an official ribbon cutting for the newly renovated Skate Park.

Last summer the Township contracted with Rampage, LLC for the installation of a new skate park ramp for the Skate Park at Ann Van Middlesworth Park.

The renovations included a new state of the art concrete skate bowl and ramp. In addition, a new bike ramp was added to the park.

“Join us on Friday evening at 6 pm for the ribbon cutting of the newly renovated park. We look forward to seeing you all there at the Skate Park. Funding for the renovations came through capital planning recommendations and investing in our parks is a priority of the Township making it One of the Best Places to live in America,” commented Deputy Mayor Gloria McCauley during the announcement.

AVM Park is nestled in Hillsborough Township, off of Amwell Road (County Road 514), at 570 Pleasant View Road. It features 71.16 acres that is home to two outdoor basketball courts, a skate park complete with bike ramps, skate bowl and grind rails, two evening illuminated ball fields (one baseball and one softball), the Neshanic Garden Club Path and Flowers, the inclusive playground, picnic pavilion, tables outdoor grills, stocked pond with fishing dock, gated dog park, walking trails and two bee hives.
