

Adult Day Center of Somerset County Celebrates 40th Anniversary

The Adult Day Center of Somerset County, a nonprofit agency committed to providing high quality, affordable day care services for disabled and elderly residents and support for care-giving families, is celebrating its 40th Anniversary.

The center originally opened in 1976 in a Bound Brook church basement and has since been relocated to Bridgewater. The ADC serves all of Somerset County, providing therapeutic activities, daily exercise programs, nursing and personal care, physical therapy, occupational therapy, consultant pharmacy, entertainment and outings. The ADC has also supported thousands of caregivers during their caregiving journey and selfless mission of helping their loved one age in place.

On May 9th, Mayor Carl Suraci and the Township Committee presented the ADC with a proclamation, recognizing the need to raise awareness of this valuable organization to the residents of Hillsborough.
