The Rotary Club of Hillsborough was originally founded on March 8, 1955 as the Rotary Club of Belle Mead. The Club meets every Wednesday at 6 p.m. at the Landing Restaurant at 311 Amwell Road.

Family Fun Day is an invitation only event where admission, special t-shirts, rides, food, games and prizes are free to special needs children and their families, including siblings. Music and lights are subdued as an accommodation to their special guests.
