DJ Lou will perform outside around fire barrels to help warm the atmosphere, alongside live performances prior to the tree being lit.

The holiday fun continues on Tuesday, December 12th, as Hillsborough Township celebrates the first night of Hanukkah, the Jewish Festival of Lights, with a Menorah lighting ceremony at 6pm.
