### **McCauley and Tomson Chosen as Mayor and Deputy Mayor for Hillsborough Township for 2018**

Hillsborough Township Committee selected Gloria McCauley as Mayor and Doug Tomson as Deputy Mayor for 2017, at the annual reorganization meeting Tuesday evening.

McCauley and Tomson were re-elected to the Hillsborough Township Committee in November, and were sworn in for a fourth and third three year term, respectively.

McCauley brings extensive knowledge and experience to the position of Mayor, beginning her 10<sup>th</sup> year on the Township Committee and having served as Deputy Mayor in 2010, 2012 and 2017 and Mayor in 2011. During her tenure on the Committee, McCauley served as liaison to many boards and functional areas including Public Safety and Emergency Services, Economic and Business Development Commission, Hillsborough-Millstone Municipal Alliance, Parks Commission, Recreation Commission, Senior Citizen Housing Council, Sign Review Committee, Sustainable Hillsborough Committee and Finance Committee.

Following her swearing in by Senator Bateman, McCauley thanked her family, friends and colleagues for their continued support. She recapped the 2017 highlights and provided an outlook for 2018, focusing on continued fiscal prudence in managing the Township's finances while monitoring the affordable housing requirements mandated by the State, working with the NJDOT on the Route 206 progress and looking forward to continuing the trail system around the municipal complex.

“It is my honor to be given the opportunity to serve as Mayor for 2018,” commented newly selected Mayor McCauley.

“This Township Committee will continue to maintain a watchful eye over the fiscal operations of the Township,” added Mayor McCauley.

Deputy Mayor Doug Tomson was also sworn in by Congressman Lance.

Tomson was sworn into his first term on January 3, 2012. Tomson served as Deputy Mayor in 2013 and Mayor in 2014 and 2015. He has served as liaison to Agricultural Advisory Committee, Board of Education, Cable Advisory Committee, Board of Health, Local Assistance Board, Library Council, Recreation and Parks Commission, and the Youth Services Commission.

“I am looking forward to supporting the Mayor this year and I promise to continue serving the public from what they expect from their local government,” commented Deputy Mayor Tomson.

The meeting concluded with the appointments to various Township Boards and Commissions for the year 2018 which was followed by light refreshments in the multi-purpose room.
