10/06/2018	Eduardo Oracion Jr., 49, of Somerville NJ, was arrested for Shoplifting from the Kohls Department Store located at 315 Rt. 206. He concealed merchandise valued at \$232.04 and attempted to leave the store without paying for it. He was processed and released pending a court appearance.
