Incident Type: Residential Structure Fire

Incident Description: On June 15, 2019 at approx. 6:30pm, the Hillsborough Twp Police responded to 100 Michelle Lane for the report of a structure fire. Responding units observed smoke and flames coming from the attached garage area of the residence. Officers determined the residence to be unoccupied of any people or pets. The responding firefighting units extinguished the fire located mainly in the garage area. The residence was deemed uninhabitable. The fire was deemed not to be suspicious but the cause is still under investigation by the Hillsborough Twp Police Dept and the Hillsborough Twp Fire Safety Bureau.
