**INTRODUCTION OF NEW ORDINANCES**

Ordinance 2007- 20

An Ordinance of the Township of Hillsborough, in the County of Somerset, New Jersey, providing for the installation of sanitary sewer lines along Arthur Road, Tara Drive and Mountainview Terrace and related expenses, in the Township of Hillsborough and appropriating \$1,000,000 therefor, and providing for the issuance of \$500,000 in bonds or notes of the Township of Hillsborough to finance the same, and directing the special assessment of the cost thereof. Further consideration and public hearing for this ordinance will be held on June 26, 2007.

Mayor Ferrera stated that this Ordinance provided the funding necessary for a sewer connection project for homes in the Mountainview Road area. Mayor Ferrera said that all costs would be repaid by the area property owners and not Hillsborough taxpayers.

Mayor Ferrera commented that the sewer connection project would be made possible because the developer of the Pleasantview Estates project, Beazer Homes, was building a sewer line in the area for its development. The Mayor said that funds borrowed for this project would be repaid through a special assessment on all property owners in the area who would benefit from the extension of the sewer line.

The Mayor said that as part of the Planning Board approval for their project Beazer Homes had pledged a \$500,000 contribution toward the sewer connection project for the property owners in the Mountainview area.

Curt Carnes, Arthur Road, brought to the Committee's attention that the correct street name was Arthur Road and not Arthur Court.

It was discussed by the Township Committee that the correct roads listed in the Ordinance should be as follows: Arthur Road, Tara Drive, Brook Drive and Mountain View Terrace.

Township Attorney Albert Cruz said since these were typographical errors they were allowed to be amended at this time.

Committeeman Suraci moved that the aforesaid Ordinance be passed, as amended, on first reading and that the Ordinance be further considered at a public hearing held on June 26, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. Said motion was seconded by Deputy Mayor Nisivoccia and approved upon call of the roll as follows:
