

ORDINANCE 2006-27

AN ORDINANCE MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF N.J.S.A. 39:1-1 ET SEQ., THE MOTOR VEHICLE CODE, APPLICABLE TO THE WILLOW ROAD BASEBALL COMPLEX AND REGULATING THE USE OF SAID ROADWAYS, STREETS, DRIVEWAYS AND PARKING LOTS BY MOTOR VEHICLES

WHEREAS, at the request of the Chief of Police, the New Jersey Department of Transportation completed a Traffic Control Survey of the Willow Road Baseball Complex in order to establish various traffic regulations on this property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Township Committee of the Township of Hillsborough has filed a written consent with the New Jersey Department of Transportation that the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:1-1 et seq., the Motor Vehicle Code, be made applicable to the roads, streets, driveways and parking lots at the Willow Road Baseball Complex located in the Township of Hillsborough, County of Somerset and the following regulations shall be enforceable:

1. General Parking:

- A. All vehicles must park in designated areas.
- B. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle upon any of the streets or parts of streets described below, except in areas covered by other parking restrictions.

C. Handicapped Parking

All stalls shall be 12 foot wide as shown on the attached Site Plan and signed with the R7-8 and R7-8P (Reserved Parking Sign and Penalty License Plate), in the designated parking areas for persons who have been issued the Handicapped Parking Permit by the Motor Vehicle Commission.

2. Speed Limits:

- A. The speed limit for both directions of travel on the following roadways are:

<u>Name of Roadway</u>	<u>M.P.H.</u>	<u>Limits</u>
All Roads and Aisles	15	Entire Length

B. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designed speed limits authorize by the Department of Transportation.

3. Tow –Away Zones:

Any vehicle parked or standing so as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic or block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, any grassy area pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner’s or operator’s expense.

4. That all signs, posts, or other necessary materials be installed and paid for by the applicant. All signing shall conform to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-183-27.

5. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, every person convicted of a violation of this Ordinance or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty or nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.

6. Effect of this Ordinance:

If any part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of the Ordinance.

7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption, passage and publication according to law.
