ORDINANCE 2005-46

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 45, TITLED "ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION", SECTION 45-2, TITLED "MEMBERSHIP", OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSBOROUGH TO ADD TWO (2) ALTERNATE MEMBERS, DESIGNATED AS "ALTERNATE NO. 1" AND "ALTERNATE NO. 2", TO THE COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hillsborough, in the County of Somerset, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Section 45-2A of the Code of the Township of Hillsborough is amended by adding the following:

The Commission shall also consist of two alternate members who shall be appointed by the Mayor and designated as "Alternate No. 1" and "Alternate No. 2."

2. Section 45-2D of the Code of the Township of Hillsborough is amended by adding the following:

The terms of the two alternate members shall be for two years, except that the term of the alternate member first appointed shall be two years for "Alternate No. 1" and one year for "Alternate No. 2", so that the term of not more than one alternate member shall expire in any one year.

3. Section 45-2 of the Code of the Township of Hillsborough is amended by adding the following as Section 45-2E:

Alternate members may participate in discussions of the proceedings but may not vote except in the absence of disqualification of a regular member. A vote shall not be delayed in order that a regular member may vote instead of an alternate member. In the event that a choice must be made as to which alternate member is to vote, "Alternate No. 1" shall vote first.
