Hillsborough Veteran Major Rob Movshin Will Serve As Memorial Day Grand Marshal

Mayor Frank DelCore announced that Hillsborough resident Rob Movshin, a 20 year Army Veteran will lead Hillsborough's 2013 Memorial Day Commemoration Ceremonies on May 25th.

Major Movshin recently returned home to Hillsborough from a nine month deployment at Kandahar Air Force Base in Afghanistan. He was part of the 117th Combat Sustainment Support Battalion of the 42nd Regional Support Group - West Trenton of the New Jersey National Guard.

Major Movshin will lead the Hillsborough Memorial Day Parade that begins at the corner of Auten and Triangle Roads at 10:30am. He will also be the featured speaker during the Garden of Honor Ceremony that begins at 11:15am at the Municipal Complex.

"It is an honor once again to commemorate Memorial Day and have all the Hillsborough Veterans lead the parade," commented Mayor Frank DelCore during his announcement.

All Hillsborough veterans are invited to participate in the Salute to Veterans Breakfast and to lead Hillsborough's Memorial Day Parade and Commemoration program on May 25th. Registration is available online at the Township's website.

"There is no group more appropriate to lead us in paying tribute to those who made the ultimate sacrifice in the service of the nation, than our military veterans," Mayor DelCore said.
