### **Free Public Secure Paper-Shredding Event on April 12<sup>th</sup> 9am – 1pm at the Somerset County Public Works Facility – 410 Roycefield Road, Hillsborough**

Somerset County will host a public paper-shredding event open to all Somerset County residents, on Saturday, April 12, 2014 from 9am-1pm at the Somerset County Public Works Facility, located at 410 Roycefield Road in Hillsborough Township.

"This is a great opportunity for residents to properly dispose of personal documents, while protecting against identity theft," stated Liaison to Public Safety Committeewoman Gloria McCauley.

This event is made possible through "Operation Secure Shred", which is sponsored by the Somerset County Board of Chosen Freeholders in cooperation with the County Division of Records Management. With assistance from the Somerset County Consumer Protection Office and the county's Records Management Office, documents will be commercially shredded safely, privately and properly by trained, licensed and bonded document-destruction specialists.

In addition to the April 12<sup>th</sup> event, there are multiple events set up throughout the County beginning on June 7<sup>th</sup> in Hillsborough. Note: Staples and paperclips do not have to be removed. Residents may bring documents in any type of container, which will be returned after papers have been dumped. Residents are permitted to stay and watch the shredding process.
