

ORDINANCE #29-09

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 412 OF THE
JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED
“SOLID WASTE” AND MORE PARTICULARLY CREATING
HOURS FOR COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Jefferson, Morris County, State of New Jersey that Chapter 412 of the Jefferson County Municipal Code, entitled “Solid Waste” is hereby amended as follows:

Section I

By creating Section 412-15, entitled “Hours of Collection of Solid Waste,” as follows:

§412-15. Hours of Collection of Solid Waste. No solid waste shall be collected by any solid waste hauler within the Township of Jefferson, whether pursuant to a Municipal contract or private contract, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. Any person or entity violating this provision, upon the first violation, shall be subject to a written warning; and upon a second or subsequent violation, shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$500, nor more than \$1,000.

Section II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section III

If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

Section IV

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and any publication as may be required by law.
