

**ORDINANCE NO. 1 - 10**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 353 OF THE  
JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED  
“PARKS” AND PROVIDING A CURFEW FOR SAID  
PUBLIC PARK PROPERTIES**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Jefferson, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 353 of the Jefferson Township Municipal Code, entitled “PARKS” is hereby amended by establishing Section 353-2 entitled “Curfew with Reference to Public Park Properties” as follows:

**SECTION I**

**Section 353-2. Curfew with Reference to Pubic Park Properties.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to be present in any public parks owned and operated by the Township of Jefferson, including all Township recreation facilities, ball fields and playgrounds, as listed by the Township Department of Recreation, between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., unless such presence falls under one of the following exceptions:

- a. The person is attending a function at any of said public parks, either organized or approved by the Township Department of Recreation;

**Section 353-3. Violations.**

Any person found in violation of this Chapter shall be subject to a fine not exceeding \$200 for the first offense, and a fine not exceeding \$500 for any subsequent offense, or a period of community service not exceeding 10 days, or any combination thereof.

**SECTION II**

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**SECTION III**

If any article, section, subsection, paragraphs, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

**SECTION IV**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final publication as provided by law.
