

ORDINANCE NO. 2-13

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 7 OF THE JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION OF GOVERNMENT" AND MORE PARTICULARLY SUBSECTION 7-37 ENTITLED "DIVISION OF POLICE" BY ADDING A NEW SUB-PARAGRAPH E

SECTION I

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, Township of Jefferson, Morris County New Jersey that Chapter 7 of the Jefferson Township Municipal Code entitled "Administration of Government" and more particularly Subsection 7-37 entitled "Division of Police" shall be amended by adding new sub-paragraph E as follows:

- E. In the appointment of any police officers to the Jefferson Township Police Department the appointing authority shall have a right pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-123.1A to grant a preference for those applicants who were residents as of the closing date of the Civil Service Examination for such position. Nothing herein shall be construed to require any applicant that is being appointed to a position in the Police Department that he be a resident as of the date of the appointment.

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION III

If any article, section, subsection, paragraphs, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final publication as provided by law.
