**“RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REJECTION OF SEALED BIDS FOR THE FIREBOAT
AND AUTHORIZING A REBID FOR SAME”**

WHEREAS, the Administrator of the Township of Jefferson caused a notice to be published in the Daily Record inviting the submission to the Jefferson Township Purchasing Office at the **Municipal Building on March 28, 2017 at 11:00 am** of sealed bids for “**Jefferson Township Fire Company #2 Fireboat**”; and

WHEREAS, the bids received are as follows:

WHEREAS, all bids substantially exceeded the cost estimates for the goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contract Law, specifically N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2(a) authorizes a municipality to reject all bids where the lowest bid substantially exceeds the cost estimates for the services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Jefferson, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that all bids are hereby rejected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Administrator is hereby authorized to re-advertise for the receipt of sealed bids for “**Jefferson Township Fire Company #2 Fireboat**” for the Township of Jefferson at such time as new boat specifications have been developed.


