ORDINANCE #17-16

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 130 OF THE JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL
CODE ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" AND MORE PARTICULARLY SUBSECTION
130-51 ENTITLED "STREETS AND SPEED LIMITS DESIGNATED"**

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Township of Jefferson in the County of Morris finds it in the interest of public safety to establish speed limits for both directions of traffic along a portion of Schoolhouse Road and Cozy Lake Road pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(b); and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Engineer has submitted and certified all the legislative requirements pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(b), and the criteria as set for by the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Bureau of Traffic Engineering and Investigations, having been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Jefferson, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 130 of the Jefferson Township Municipal Code, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" and more particularly Subsection 130-51 entitled "Streets and Speed Limits Designated" is amended as follows:

SECTION I

§130-51A entitled "Streets and Speed Limits Designated" is amended by deleting subsections (5) entitled "Cozy Lake Road" and (13) entitled "Schoolhouse Road" in their entirety, and replacing same with the following:

- (5) Cozy Lake Road.
 - (a) From Berkshire Valley Road to the center of Cross Road; 35 miles per hours; thence
 - (b) To the northerly Jefferson Township line: 45 miles per hour.

- (13) Schoolhouse Road.
 - (a) From Dover-Milton Road to Ridge Road (with the exception of the certain school speed limit of 25 miles per hour from 130 feet north of the center of Greenwood Drive to 600 feet north of the center of Greenwood Drive during recess, during opening and closing hours, or while children are going to or leaving school): 35 miles per hour; thence
 - (b) From Ridge Road to northerly terminus of Schoolhouse Road: 25 miles per hour.

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION III

If any article, section, subsection, paragraphs, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final publication as provided by law.
