ORDINANCE NO. 5-13

ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 20-08 WHICH WAS AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-05, ESTABLISHING SALARIES, HOLIDAYS, BENEFITS AND CERTAIN JOB REGULATIONS OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JEFFERSON, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Jefferson, County of Morris, and State of New Jersey, that Ordinance 20-08 is hereby amended by increasing the hourly charge for police officers for contracted services entered into with the Police Department of Jefferson Township, as follows:

SECTION I

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Effective June 22, 2013, officers working outside employment, pursuant to contracted police services as set forth in Section 7-38 of the Jefferson Township Code, shall be paid in accordance with the following schedule:

<u>TITLE</u>	<u>MINIMUM</u>	<u>MAXIMUM</u>
Police Officer	75.000 per hour	75.000 per hour
Sergeant	75.000 per hour	75.000 per hour
Lieutenant	75.000 per hour	75.000 per hour
Captain	75.000 per hour	75.000 per hour

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION III

If any article, section, subsection, paragraphs, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final publication as provided by law.
