

ORDINANCE NO. 17-13

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 47 OF THE CODE
BOOK OF JEFFERSON TOWNSHIP, COUNTY OF MORRIS
AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, ENTITLED “FIRE
DEPARTMENT” AND MORE PARTICULARLY, SECTION 47-
5 ENTITLED “ATTENDANCE AND DUTY”**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Jefferson, County of Morris, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 47 of the Jefferson Township Municipal Code, entitled “Fire Department” and more particularly Subsection 5 entitled “Attendance and Duty” is hereby amended by deleting in its entirety Subsection 5, and in its place and stead shall be the following:

SECTION A

§47.5 Every active member of the Jefferson Township Fire Department shall in each and every year maintain a percentage of at least 50% of fires and drills combined. After seven years of maintaining 50%, said member shall become state exempt and shall be allowed to maintain 30% of fires and drills combined. Each company shall maintain a record of attendance of each member and shall report the same to the Director of Public Safety annually.

SECTION B

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

SECTION C

If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

SECTION D

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final publication as provided by law.
