

**RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING BOARD OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF LACEY, COUNTY OF OCEAN,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, RECOMMENDING THE
ADOPTION OF AN ADDENDUM TO THE LACEY
TOWNSHIP MASTER PLAN CIRCULATION ELEMENT**

WHEREAS, during 1997, the Lacey Township Planning Board conducted a periodic reexamination of the Lacey Township Master Plan and Development Regulations of the Township in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Land Use Law; and

WHEREAS, as part of that reexamination report, the Planning Board recommended certain amendments to the Lacey Township Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, at a public hearing conducted on November 30, 1998, the Lacey Township Planning Board adopted an amendment to the Circulation Element of the Lacey Township Master Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Board of the Township of Lacey, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Township of Lacey does hereby memorialize the adoption of an amendment to the Circulation Element of the Lacey Township Master Plan, which document consists of the annexed Addendum to the Lacey Township Master Plan, together with the map referred to therein and made a part thereof.

2. The aforesaid Circulation Map is intended to become a part of the Lacey Township Master Plan and designate existing and proposed future roadways together with pedestrian ways and bikeways.

3. This amendment, entitled "Addendum to the Lacey Township Master Plan", was adopted after public notice and public hearing in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Land Use Law.

4. A certified copy of this Resolution, together with the Addendum and Map, should be forwarded to the Lacey Township Committee; the Ocean County Planning Board and the Clerks of all adjacent municipalities.

**ADDENDUM TO THE
LACEY TOWNSHIP MASTER PLAN**

The Lacey Township Planning Board conducted a comprehensive review and analysis of the Lacey Township Master Plan during calendar year 1997 and determined that amendments were appropriate in certain areas. This addendum is intended to constitute an amendment to the Lacey Township Master Plan Circulation Element. The adoption of this amendment shall incorporate the map entitled, "Addendum To Circulation Element - Lacey Township Master Plan, Ocean County, New Jersey". The map illustrates existing and proposed collector roadways as well as proposed or existing pedestrian ways.

By adopting this map, it is the intention of the Lacey Township Planning Board to designate areas which should be considered collector roadways and pedestrian ways, both now and in the future, including specifically, the former Central Railroad Right-of-Way of New Jersey and the extension of Newark Avenue to Cambridge Road as well as the extension of Sunrise Boulevard and Laurel Boulevard to connect to the Railroad Right-of-Way.

This finding is adopted in direct result of the determination of the Planning Board as a part of the Master Plan review process that significant increases in traffic have occurred since the adoption of the last Re-examination Report and that steps are needed to address those concerns.

It is also the belief of the Planning Board that the expansion of the Lacey Township roadway network is also necessary in order to provide for the future increases in traffic which will result from current development trends and patterns.

Further, the Planning Board finds that bikeways, as well as pedestrian ways, should be incorporated into all plans for collector and arterial streets and roadways.

Finally, as a part of this amendment to the Master Plan, the Lacey Township Planning Board formally recommends to the Lacey Township Committee that the addendum to the Circulation Element, with the information contained thereon, be incorporated into an official map to be adopted by the Township of Lacey for the purposes of encouraging the acquisition of those properties required in order to

complete the Circulation Plan contemplated by this amendment.

The Planning Board further finds that in order to correct circulation patterns in the Lacey Road/Manchester Avenue area that the Township Committee should explore the feasibility of and, if possible, construct an additional roadway providing access to the new Lacey Township Middle School from Manchester Avenue, possibly along Adams Avenue.
