RE-EXAMINATION REPORT FOR 1997

WHEREAS, the Municipal Land Use law requires a periodic re-examination of the Municipal Master Plan by the Planning Board to be conducted at least once each six (6) years; and

WHEREAS, beginning in 1996, and continuing through 1997, the Lacey Township Planning Board conducted a comprehensive re-examination of its municipal Master Plan and certain of its development regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Lacey Township Planning Board formally voted to adopt said Re-examination Report at its December 19, 1997 meeting;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Board of the Township of Lacey, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, that the Board does hereby formally adopt the annexed municipal Master Plan Re-examination Report.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of said Report and this Resolution shall be forwarded by the Planning Board Secretary to the Ocean County Planning Board and the Municipal Clerk of each adjoining municipality as required by law.
