2. Hearings

a). Daniel Marafino - 19 Church Street  
Mr. Marafino made a presentation before the group to be allowed to install vinyl siding to the rear portion of his house at 19 Church Street. The board approved a 3" over 3" siding. He will temporarily re-install a metal awning on the north side of the house. He intends to replace this later this year at which time he'll need another petition for a certificate of appropriateness.

3. Minutes The minutes from the meeting held on April 19, 2000 were approved (moved by Pecqueur/seconded by Giallanza).

4. Treasurer's Report

Mr. Keysa has transferred funds in the accounts so as to pay for the plagues for the buildings listed on the National Register. Profession Services balance = \$203.93/office supplies = \$1,795.60/total = \$1,999.53. It is anticipated that all or almost all of this will be expended by the end of the fiscal year on 5/31/00 as the plagues will cost \$1,415.95.
