APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES:

Bill Harnack made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Joe Giallanza.

OLD BUSINESS:

A) Broadway:

- 1) Status: The Village meeting was on 5/16/98 and a tour of the area was held on 5/21/98. Jim Keysa reported that each group gave their thought as to what they wanted with regards to the widening project. Everyone agreed on requesting the following:
 - > That no parking be permitted on Broadway.
 - > Request that all utilities be placed underground.
 - > That the new curbs be made over with sandstone or granite.



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- > Keep the widening to 37' with 3 lanes from the East Village Line to 100 ft West of Park Blvd.
- > Extend the project from Park Blvd to Lake Ave.
- > Include amenities such as trees, benches, lights, bridge, etc.
- > Have the DOT start planting a variety of trees now and also save as many as possible during project.
- > Start the process of removing Route 20 as a truck route.
- > Coordinate plans with the CBD.
- > Begin the project involving removing the entering/exiting roads to the Municipal Building.
- > Aurora Street to West Village Line was to be determined after further review. An oral decision was made to widen to 3 lanes with a striped 4th for turning lane.

B) Resolution by Village of Lancaster:

The Planning Board will submit this to the DOT in the near future.

- 2) Tree Ordinance: Everyone was once again asked to go over these ordinances and this will definitely be tabled at our next meeting.

b) SBL Numbers:

These have been submitted to Elaine Salvo for recording.

c) National Register Process: Taylor & Taylor:

No updates to report as Dave Taylor was not present.

d) Prior hearings:

The list has been submitted previously to Dan Bacarri for citing the 5 stated properties. No change in status.



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- e) The sesquicentennial/Village of Lancaster:
Jim did not attend the 2nd organizational meeting, although he heard they had come up with many ideas to try to incorporate in the celebration.
- f) Replacement for board member, Paul Kendall:
A motion was made by Joe Giallanza, seconded by Paul Kendall to have Dr. Ronald Batt replace Paul Kendall on the board. Mary will send a letter to Dr. Batt informing him of our decision and let him know when the next meeting will be held.

- a) NFTC Lancaster North South Corridor Study:

Jim received a copy of the study which described 8 different alternatives. This will be in his office for anyone who would like to review this.
