Broadway Project

-Mr. Chris Brunea stated that he will get some notice before they do the 30-day section of the E.I.S. He has again stated that he believes we will need outside help in studying the report. It was suggested that we recruit some schools to help us. Students could be helpful in car counting and other aspects of the study.
