OLD BUSINESS

Re-appointment of Historic District Board Members

- According to Mayor Cansdale the Board members have been re-

oath book in the Clerk/Treasurer's office.

Signs

- Dr. Duane Redlinski reported that Gina has given the new signs
and the property owners list to him. He reported that the
signs will go up soon. Also, Mr. Keysa asked that Mr. Chris
Brunea write up new petitions for the public to sign. It was
suggested that the petitions be placed at the bank and Pete
Sweets' Station. Dr. Duane Redlinski will distribute them.

Grants

- Mrs. Judy Michaels reported that there has not been much
movement on the grants but that Mrs. Jean Brunea has
someone who may be able to help in the grant writing.
Mr. Keysa gave Mrs. Michaels more grant info.

Metro News Articles

- Ms. Deanna Bartha and Mr. Keysa are working on the articles and
they probably will not appear in the paper until Sept. The
articles will describe the Historic District and some of
the buildings in the district.

Broadway Status

- The Buffalo News on 8/1/93 ran an article discussing NFTA's
proposal to build a by-pass transit line that would link
Southwestern Blvd. in Orchard Park to Broadway near Bowen
Rd. in Lancaster. The relief route could continue north
from Broadway to connect with the Thruway in northern Lanc.,
under the proposal. Mr. Keysa asked the Mayor to contact the
NFTC to let them know that the Village supports this plan
and send a copy to the DOT.

It was decided that some of the Historic Board members should attend a meeting on this proposal.

- Mr. Keysa reported a discussion with the DOT in regards to the Broadway widening. The feeling Mr. Keysa got about the plan was that the DOT may be considering modifying it.
- The DOT has not given us any more info. on their project.

Rowhouses 5481-5485 Broadway

- Mr. Mark Lee contacted Mr. Keysa in regards to the rowhouses. The middle owner is requesting a loan with Mr. Lee's company for repairs. Mr. Lee requested info. on the District. Gina will send a District property owners packet to him.

Lutheran Church

- Mr. Stribing requested that we recognize the church as a local landmark. The church is celebrating their centennial. It was discussed and decided to have a plaque made. Motion by Dr. Paul Kendall, seconded by Ms. Judy Michaels to spend up to \$60.00 for a commemorative plaque. Motion passed.

Awareness Walk

- The date set for the walk is Sat., Sept. 18, 1993 at 1:00 P.M. The Walk hopefully will enlightening the public on the charm and beauty of Broadway. Also, we hope it will let them know more about the DOT's plans.

NEW BUSINESS

Church Street Repaving

- A letter from Mr. Keysa was sent to the Lanc. Village Board asking them to look into the possibility of scraping the blacktop off of Church St. and leaving it brick.
- The Lanc. Bee ran an article in regards to the Church St. repaving but called it Clark St. by mistake. The Bee will run a correction in next weeks paper.
- Part of Niagara Falls Blvd. and part of Main St. in East Aurora have brick paving and have found no problems with it. It was discussed that the brick street would give charm to the Historic area.
- Mayor Cansdale said he would speak with Trustee O'Neal about this issue and they would let us know.
