11/5/92 Mrs. Judy Michaels and the Depew Fire Dept. are meeting with Chief Maccrone to discuss the Broadway project. Mrs. Michaels will bring notes from the previous Fire Depts. meeting. She will bring up the problems that we have discussed and report back to us at the next meeting.

-It has been brought to our attention that the DOT has no plans for the scoping sessions. Mrs. Michaels suggested that Mr. Brunea write a letter to the DOT questioning their plans for a scoping session and send copies to the legislators and media.

-Mrs. Michaels has talked to the NFTC. The man she spoke with stated that their organization doesn't believe that widening Broadway is the right answer to Broadway's problems.

-Mr. Robert Deutschlander stated that he thinks it's time we contact the legislators. After some discussion it was decided to invite the following officials to our next meeting: Senators Volker, D'Amato, Monynihan, Assemblymen Tolkasz & Graber, Rep. Quinn, Lanc. Village Dept. Heads, Depew & Lanc. Police and Fire Chiefs. We will have our guests arrive at 8:00 P.M. We will begin our meeting at 7:00 P.M.
