HEARINGS

Minutes of November 4, 1992 meeting

-The only correction for these minutes is on Page 2, the deadline for the CLG grants should be Nov. 2, 1992.
Motion by Ms. Judy Michaels, seconded by Mrs. Jean Brunea to accept the minutes with the above correction. Motion passed.

TREASURER'S REPORT

-F.O.B. balance is the same as last month, \$1,590.54.

OLD BUSINESS

Certified Local Government Grants

-Ms. Michaels spoke with Mr. Lucian Greco in the Town and they are interested in applying with us for a grant. Mrs. Breyer will send a letter to us verifying our stand with SHIPO and she will send a copy to Ms. Lucy Curley (Town grant writer) to clear up any misunderstanding in the grant process.

Letter to Property Owners

-The cover letter is finished and ready for copying. Mr. Baccari needs to get us the forms his is revising for us. The cover letter and forms will be mailed out together.

Correspondence

- Received and filed letter from Preservation League.
- Received and filed an article from Ms. Brunea in regards to hardwood trees.

NEW BUSINESS

Aerial Photos

- Mr. Chris Brunea suggested that we have some aerial photos taken of the Broadway sections that are in question for widening. Aerial views may give a better look at the intersection etc. Mr. Brunea will check the costs of a project like this.

D.O.T. E.I.S Study

- Mr. Brunea found a decision that states that the D.O.T. must do E.I.S. Study in an Historic District for even a stop light, which backs up our position that a E.I.S. Study for the Broadway Project must be done.

Elections

Historic District

- The positions of Chairman and Vice-Chairman are up of election.
- Motion by Ms. Jean Brunea, seconded by Ms. Judy Michaels to nominate Mr. Jim Keysa as chairperson and Mr. Bill Harnack as vice-chairperson. Motion passed.
- Terms to run to June 30, 1993 and will be re-affirmed at that time.

Friends of Broadway

- The positions of Co-Chairpersons are up for election.
- Currently the positions are held by Mr. Jim Delacy and Mr. Bob Deutschlander. Neither of these members were present for the discussion.
- Motion by Ms. Jean Brunea, seconded by Mr. Chris Brunea to nominate Dr. Duane Redlinski and Ms. Judy Micheals as co-chairpersons.
- Motion by Ms. Jean Brunea, seconded by Ms. Judy Michaels to temporarily eliminate the position of secretary.
- Motion by Ms. Judy Michaels, seconded by Mr. Edward Mikula that Ms. Kathryn Kochli continue as treasurer.
- Vote on above motions to take place at the next meeting.
- Terms for these positions to run from July 1 to June 30.

Broadway Project

- Received and filed letter from the D.O.T. in regards to the Broadway project asking us and other area organizations our input on their plans for the widening. Mr. Brunea thinks this may be their idea of a scoping session. The letter asks us to respond before December 23, 1992, which we feel is an unrealistic deadline in view of the holidays and the fact that we don't know what their actual plans are.

-Mr. Deutschlander set up a meeting with Sen. Volker, Mr. Keysa, Assemblyman Graber, Mr. Richard Bulman, Mr. Jim Smith and Dr. Duane Redlinski. Some of the things that were discussed were as follows:

- 1.) Results of the Widening survey:
 - Volker's results = 60% against
 - Graber's results = 70% against
- 2.) Issues: bridges, sewers & waterlines and support for the widening in the Village of Depew (which has dissipated).
- 3.) Timetable for project as follows:
 - Draft E.I.S. in library = March 1993
 - Hearing = June 1993
 - Start project = Late 1994 or Early 1995
- 3.) Senator Volker is worried that the poor condition of the bridges will cause Broadway to be shut down.
- 4.) Mr. Bulman mentioned the detours and how they would hurt the businesses.
- 5.) They spoke about the temporary alternate truck routes and to get permanent alternate truck routes would be more difficult.
- 6.) They discussed the detours for the bridges, stating that the Depew bridge would almost have to have an alternate bridge because a detour would be too long.
- 7.) The money to do Broadway is bond money, but there is no money to do new waterlines.
- 8.) They also feel that the December 23, 1992 deadline is an unrealistic time for our response.

-Mr. Keysa assigned different aspects of the project to members of the board to write up some questions for the scoping session.
