Mr. Roth presented a list of homes within the village that have the type of bay he would like to add to his home. Mr. Roth also presented a sketch of the bay.

Motion by Edward Mikula, seconded by Johnstone Reid, Jr., to approve a certificate of appropriateness for the addition of a bay, as presented on the attached sketch, with the exception that the siding be brought down to ground level or consider a box bay addition with a shed roof.

Chairman Keysa discussed political signs.

Angelo Daluisio explained the status of the political signs and the opinion submitted by the Village Attorney.

Chairman Keysa stated the Historic District members would like to amend the suggestions submitted to the Village Board for changes in the sign code of the Village. Under prohibited signs throughout the village:

3.) Any sign attached to a vehicle, either parked in the right of way or on private property as to be visible from street; which sign is designed to advertise or otherwise direct attention to a business establishment located at or near the place where the vehicle is parked.


4.) Political signs - size of sign not to exceed six square feet.

At 8:15 p.m., Mr. Reid, Jr. excused himself from the meeting.

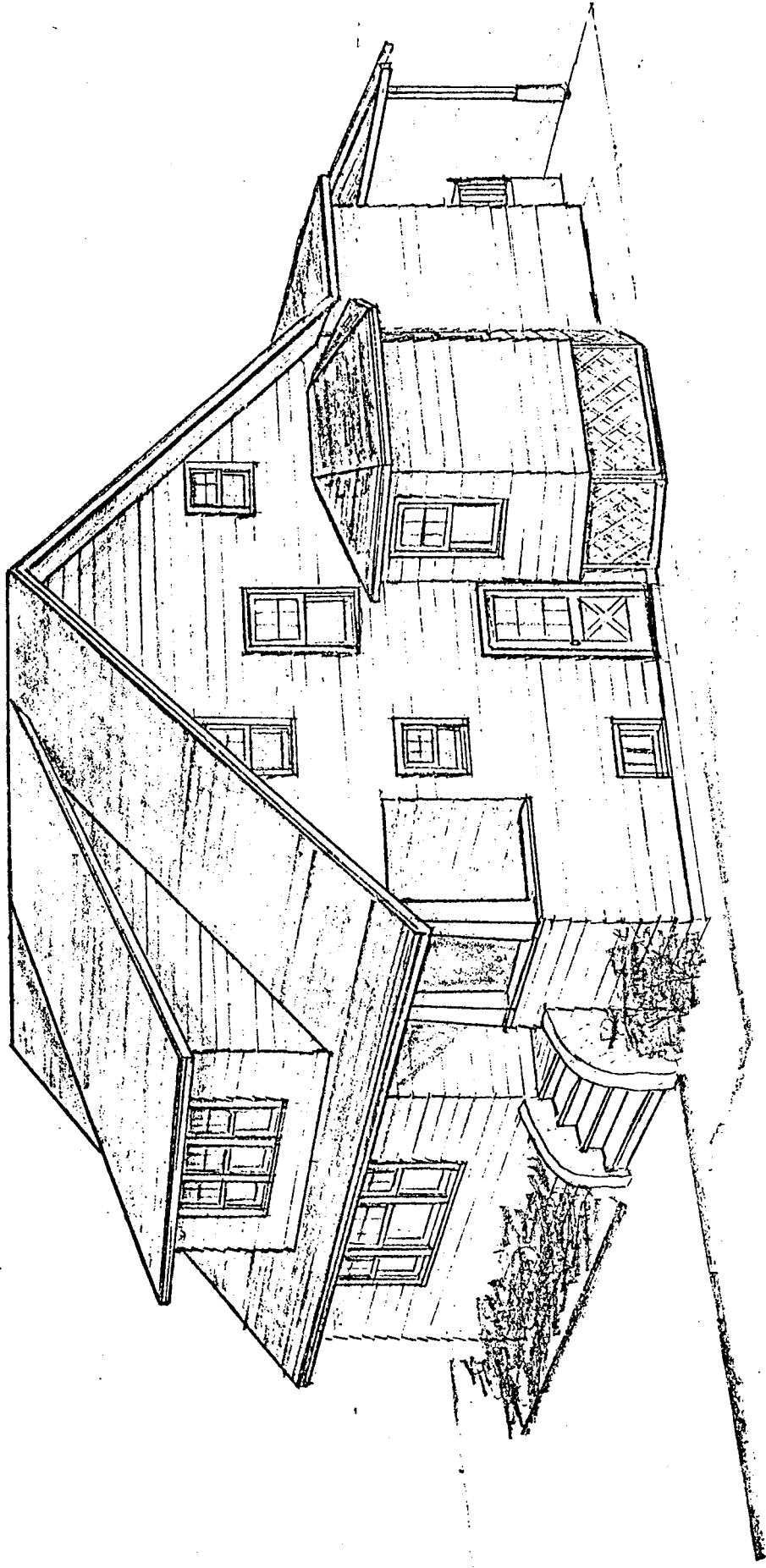
Chairman Keysa discussed the renovation of the municipal building. One of the items discussed was the grill work for the windows.
