Mr. Keysa stated the Historic District can do nothing at the present time as the building is not being altered.

Mr. Daluisio stated the Village of Lancaster Planning Commission has approved the operation of the pizzeria and has made its recommendation to the Village Board.

Mr. Daluisio had notified Chairman Keysa that the Lancaster Community Baptist Church, 5575 Broadway, has covered the redwood siding with beige siding. Chairman Keysa directed the Clerk to notify the elders of the Baptist Church that they must appear before the Historic Committee before any more changes are made.

Chairman Keysa requested the Clerk to notify Charles E. Marks, 17 Clark Street, he resides in the Historic District and must appear before the Historic District Board before any changes can be made.

Chairman Keysa has been informed the barn behind the Presbyterian Church will be torn down to enlarge the parking area.

Joe Brunet requested the Clerk to get a copy of the present sign code from Village of Williamsville.

Dr. Bunting not present but is making progress on the brochure


Johnstone Reid, Jr. presented a sketch and list of possible names for a Historic District plaque which may be presented on an annual basis.
