Historic District Meeting was held in the Lancaster Historical Museum, 40 Clark Street, Lancaster, New York on July 20, 1988.

Chairman Keysa called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.

Motion by Michael Meyer, seconded by Johnstone Reid, Jr., to approve the minutes of the June 22, 1988 meeting.

Patricia Taylor requested a Certificate of Appropriateness for a sign to be installed in front of the property at 5497 Broadway. Sign will read "Pat Taylor School of Dance". Also, submitted a letter from Robert A. Sharpe, secretary for the Masonic Temple stating the Masonic Temple's approval of the sign provided it is approved by the Lancaster Historic District members.

Motion by Jean Brunea, seconded by Johnstone Reid, Jr., to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness to Pat Taylor to install a white sign 2' by 3', with black letters, in front of 5497 Broadway. Set back of sign from sidewalk to be eight (8) feet. If lighting is to be considered another petition will be necessary.

Patricia Matteson, 27 Church Street submitted a Petition for a Certificate of Appropriateness requesting permission to have white vinyl siding - triple 3's, with white trim installed on her home.

Motion by Jean Brunea, seconded by Michael Meyer, to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness to Patricia Matteson, 27 Church Street, for triple 3's white vinyl siding.


CARRIED
