Historic District Meeting was held in the Lancaster Historical Museum, 40 Clark Street, Lancaster, New York - October 19, 1988 at 8:00 p.m.

Mr. George Kuntz, contractor for Picasso's, presented a sketch of the new pitched, green fiberglass shingle roof; for the building at 5413 Broadway. The 4 X 12 pitched roof will cover the existing flat roof to prevent additional water damage.

Motion by Michael Meyer, seconded by Jean Brunea, to grant a Certificate of Appropriateness to D.R.M. Management Co., 5413 Broadway, Lancaster, New York for a pitched roof as presented in the petition.

Chairman Keysa contacted Edward Garrett, New York State Department of Transportation, regarding the widening of Broadway. Mr. Garrett does not have any additional information since being contacted in August. Mr. Keysa was informed the Public Hearing will be held late in 1989, or early in 1990, for the widening of Broadway and Project will be let in 1992.

Chairman Keysa contacted Robert Russell, D.O.T., requesting status report.

Chairman Keysa reported on his meeting with Mayor Hadsall to discuss the Municipal Building. Sign reviewed for the front of the building. Also, discussed redesigning of entranceway and new landscaping, aluminum grillwork for windows, possibility of removing driveways and vehicles will gain access to the Municipal building from Legion Parkway.

Joseph Brunet, Jr. informed Jean Brunea he will be submitting his resignation and will turn over his paperwork on the brochure to the Historic District.
