Margaret Stock questioned moving price sign from Central Avenue to Broadway. Chairman Keysa suggested removing logo on the side of building facing Broadway and replacing logo with price sign.

Mr. Hand stated replacing of logo would not make price sign visible to people coming west on Broadway.

Margaret Stock suggested Mr. Hand's request for additional signage be tabled until the next scheduled meeting. Members present agreed to table request.

Motion by Margaret Stock, seconded by Johnstone Reid to hold Mr. Hand's request for a price sign in advance for further discussion at the next meeting at which time more members will be present.
