Mr. Keysa requested a copy of letter be presented to the Village Board and Planning Commission with a request for their participation in opposing the passage of the Bill.

Margaret Stock suggested the Board Members of the Presbyterian Church be invited to a meeting with this committee to familiarize them with Historic Preservation.
