Jean Brunea called the meeting to order and introduced Edward Banck, owner of Banck Construction Company - vinyl window manufacturer. Mr. Banck explained the proposed window replacement at the Masonic Temple. The bottom section of the window will be a slider, center section a one lite stationary window and the top section of the window (wagon wheel) will be covered with vinyl covered masonite.

Johnstone Reid objected to the proposed change in the configuration of the top section of the window and stated any change in this section would ruin the integrity of the window.

Jean Brunea stated the Historic District members would like to see the buildings or homes where Mr. Banck has installed the wagon wheel windows. Also, requested the addresses in the Allentown area from Mr. Banck where the wagon wheel windows have been installed by his company.


Margaret Stock stated she and members of the district would like to see the large section (middle) of window with dividers.

Jean Brunea excused Johnstone Reid and Margaret Stock, Mr. Banck and Mr. Merkle from the meeting.

Angelo Daluisio discussed the sign ordinance for the Village of Lancaster.

The Clerk to give the Historic District members copies of the sign ordinance and request sample copies of Historic District Ordinances from General Code Publishers.
