Clerk to prepare forms for all Historic District members for filling vacancy when vacancy occurs.

Motion by Margaret Stock, seconded by Jean Brunea, Clerk to send copies of blue forms to the Lancaster Library and Town Historian.

Margaret Stock suggested that at each meeting the members should direct the Clerk which information should be forwarded to the Lancaster Library.

Angelo Daluisio presented copies of the sign ordinance from the Towns of Lancaster and Amherst.

Motion by John Bunting, seconded by Jean Brunea, that the portable signs in the Historic District be prohibited, grandfather clause of one year for existing signs in the Historic District, and address portable signs on a village wide basis.

Mr. Davidson - Faith United Methodist Church, presented plans to rebuild the Church - Cost of rebuilding \$667,000 - which includes full basement, large room-youth activities, seating for 214 people, third floor corridor, balcony, brick and stucco on outside of building.

Historic District members strongly recommended red brick.

Motion by John Bunting, seconded by Jean Brunea, to approve the plans submitted by Mr. Davidson for re-building Faith United Methodist Church.
