CALL TO ORDER

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

OLD BUSINESS

26-2019 Consider the request from Erin Dixon to have a No Parking from Here to Corner placed at the corner of Atlantic Ave and Chester St.

Response:

- *Mayor Sorace requested to keep this tabled to have someone take a look at this.*
- *Mayor Sorace made a motion to table the request, seconded by Mr. Mandros. The motion was unanimously approved.*

28-2019 Consider the request from Owen Wood to address safety concerns at the bend on Tennyson Drive.

Response:

- *Mayor Sorace would like to have a follow up with Mr. Owen before finalizing.*
- *Mr. Evans made a motion to table the request for a follow up, seconded by Mr. Soto. The motion was unanimously approved.*

34-2019 Consider the request from Mrs. Polanco to have an exemption to the permit parking on 100 block of S. Marshall St. as well as a handicap space in the area of 116 S. Marshall St.

Response:

- *Chief Berkihiser stated it is an issue with Garden Court providing only one handicap space per building.*
- *Mr. Evans agreed with placing a handicap space, but a permit would be required.*
- *Handicap parking allows for public use for anyone with a handicap placard/plate.*
- *Mr. Evans suggested contacting the management to see if they could create an additional handicap space in the private lot.*
- *Mayor Sorace suggested a follow up phone call with Mrs. Polanco and Garden Court property manager to arrange for a dedicated spot for her.*
- *Sgt. Luciano will make contact with Garden Court apartments.*
- *Mr. Evans made a motion to table the request to make contact with Garden Court, seconded by Mayor Sorace. The motion was unanimously approved.*
