

Regular Meeting

January 3, 2012

The regular meeting of the Millcreek Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 9:52 a.m. by Chairman Figaski in the Assembly Room of the Millcreek Township Municipal Building. Present were Gerald Wolf, Joseph Kujawa, Brian McGrath, Richard Figaski, Evan Adair, Esq., Phyllis Vollbrecht, and Richard Morris, P.E.

Chairman Figaski called for public comment on agenda items other than development or rezoning applications. No comments were received.

It was moved by Mr. McGrath and seconded by Mr. Kujawa to approve payment of the weekly General Fund bills in the amount of \$508,723.78 and the Sewer Revenue Fund bills in the amount of \$83,660.20. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

It was moved by Mr. Kujawa and seconded by Mr. McGrath to adopt Resolution 2012-R-3; a Resolution of the Board of Supervisors that effective January 1, 2012, and continuing until such time as changed by later adopted resolution of the Township Board of Supervisors, the amount of participant contributions to be paid into the Millcreek Township Police Pension Plan shall be set at the rate of five percent (5%) of the participant's compensation. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

Mr. Kujawa moved, Mr. McGrath seconded to employ Devin M. Faulhauber as Recycling Clerk to begin January 6, 2012 at the rate of \$15.38 per hour, conditioned on the successful passing of a physical and drug screening. No public comment was received. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

It was moved by Mr. Kujawa and seconded by Mr. Figaski that Mr. McGrath be permitted to attend, in his capacity as Roadmaster and Administrator of Public Safety, the PSATS quarterly meeting from January 23 to 25, 2012 in Hershey, PA. All expenses will be paid by PSATS. No public comment was received. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote.

There being no citizens to be heard or further business to come before the Board, it was moved by Mr. Kujawa and seconded by Mr. McGrath to adjourn the meeting at 9:55 a.m. Motion carried.
