**Executive Session: Resolution 8-2010:** Mr. Gabris made a motion to enter Executive Session seconded by Mr. Graebener. RCV: Yeas: Mr. Gabris, Mr. Graebener, Mr. Kennedy, Ms. Polk, Mayor St. Amour. Clerk read Resolution 8-2010 in full to discuss the position of the Chief of Police. Mr. Kennedy made a motion to come back to Regular Session seconded by Mr. Graebener. RCV: Yeas: All voted yes.
