Public Works: Ms. Rheault reported the following: Public Works has been busy installing and inspecting all salt augers and salt spinners on the vehicles, chipping the Township, patching pot holes, repairing shoulders of roadways, maintenance to Pine Cone Zone play area. Ms. Rheault reported we have received approval from NJ Department of Transportation for a sixth month extension for the reconstruction of Indian Cabin Road. Ms. Rheault added we are seeking applicants for the opening of a Heavy Equipment Operator and requested official clarification if she can plow as a Public Official.

Department of Administration: Mr. Gabris reported the following: Municipal offices will be closed Wednesday, November 11th for Veteran's Day. Also, Municipal offices will be closed November 26th and 27th for Thanksgiving.
