

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND PARK TOWNSHIP, MICHIGAN, CODE OF ORDINANCES,
ARTICLE III, SECTION 36-42, NO WAKE ZONE.**

WHEREAS; Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for the State of Michigan has recommended no-wake zone changes for Lake Macatawa.

WHEREAS; if the recommendation of the DNR is not approved by the local unit, the previous recommendations and regulations remain in effect.

WHEREAS; it is the desire of the Township and City of Holland to implement these changes effective immediately, but that is the ultimate decision of the DNR.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that Article III, section 36-42 be amended to read as follows in its entirety.

Section 1: Lake Macatawa, “Pine Creek Bay” – High-speed Boating and Waterskiing Hours

On the waters of Pine Creek Bay, Lake Macatawa, lying north of the latitudinal line 42° 47' 10"N, (42.78611), Park Township, Ottawa County, it shall be unlawful for the operator of any motorboat, during the period from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 a.m. of the following day, or from 7:30 p.m. to 11:00 a.m. of the following day when daylight saving time is in effect, to:


- (a) Operate such motorboat at high speed, which is defined as a speed at or above which a motorboat reaches a planing condition.
- (b) Have in tow, or otherwise assist in the propulsion of a person on water skis, water sled, surfboard, or other similar contrivance.

The boundaries of the area described above shall be marked with signs and/or with buoys and maintained by the Township. All buoys must be placed as provided in a permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources and be in conformance with the State Uniform Waterway Marking System. Buoys shall not be placed in a commercial shipping channel.


Section 2: Severability. This Ordinance and the various parts, sections, sentences, phrases and clauses are declared to be severable. If any portion of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3: Repeal. All resolutions, ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of any such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4: Effective Date. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Park Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, on June 8, 2017 and is ordered to take effect on July 1, 2017, said date being immediately after publication in the *Holland Sentinel*, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township, pursuant to the provisions of Act 246 of the Public Acts of 1945, as amended.


