

## EXCERPT OF MINUTES

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Park Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, held on the 14th day of September, 2017, at 6:30 p.m. The meeting was held at the Township Hall, 52 – 152nd Avenue, Holland, Ottawa County, Michigan.

### RESOLUTION # 2017-12

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Park Township, Ottawa County, Michigan, held a public hearing on September 14, 2017 to receive testimony and public comments on the issue of millage rates to levy in 2017. Due to a technical change in the taxing authority status of the Library, a Truth in Taxation public hearing was not required for 2017. Ignoring the impact of the Library millage, the maximum millage that could normally be levied without a public hearing for the Township's remaining levies would be 2.9986 mills. With a hearing, the maximum levy would have been 3.0252 mills, a difference of .0266 mills; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board's intent to discuss millage levies was not required to be published. However, in the interest of transparency a notice was duly published by the Township Clerk consistent with the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interest of the Township to levy an additional millage rate of 0.0266 mills on the Township's remaining levies

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved that the Township Board of Park Township, Ottawa County, Michigan does hereby approve the levy of an additional millage rate of 0.0266 mills, and does hereby establish the 2017 Park Township millage rates as follows:

1. Allocated, Operating millage – .9168;
2. Voted, Parks – .4856
3. Voted, E-Unit – .6514;
4. Voted, Bicycle Path – .3884;
5. Voted, West Michigan Airport Authority – .0969; and
6. Voted, Local Streets – .4861


