

RESOLUTION NO. 12-2014

**A RESOLUTION OF PENNSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL APPROVING AN INTERMUNICIPAL TRANSFER OF LIQUOR LICENSE NO. R-18695 FROM McKEEVER'S NORTH WALES, INC., PRESENTLY UTILIZED AT 101 S. FIFTH STREET, NORTH WALES, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO WEIS MARKETS, INC., LOCATED AT 498 POTTSTOWN AVENUE, PENNSBURG BOROUGH, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.**

**WHEREAS**, on July 11, 2014, the Borough of Pennsburg received a request to transfer an existing liquor license utilized by McKeever's North Wales, Inc., located at 101 S. Fifth Street, North Wales, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, to Weis Markets, Inc., 498 Pottstown Avenue, Pennsburg, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Act 85 of 2006, the Pennsburg Borough Council held a public hearing on Tuesday, August 5, 2014, at 7:30 p.m. pursuant to public notice; and

**WHEREAS**, the Act requires the Applicant to obtain from the receiving municipality, a Resolution approving the inter-municipal transfer of the liquor license prior to the Applicant's submission of an application to the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; and

**WHEREAS**, based upon the information provided by the Applicant at the hearing, Pennsburg Borough Council is satisfied that the approval of said transfer of the liquor license would not adversely affect the welfare, health, peace and morals of the Borough or its residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND RESOLVED** by the Pennsburg Borough Council, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Pennsburg Borough Council hereby approves the request of Weis Markets, Inc., to transfer Liquor License No. R-18695 (currently licensed to McKeever's North Wales, Inc., and currently in safekeeping with PLCB, for previously licensed premises at 101 South Fifth Street,


North Wales, Pennsylvania, 19454) to operate a restaurant facility within the Borough of Pennsburg, to be located at 498 Pottstown Avenue, Pennsburg, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, 18073.


**SECTION 2.** That Pennsburg Borough Council has held a properly advertised public hearing pursuant to the notice provisions of Section 102 of the Liquor Code to receive comments on the proposed liquor license transfer.

**SECTION 3.** That the transfers, designations, and assignment licenses hereunder are subject to approval by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board and that the Borough's approval is conditioned upon the Applicant complying with all applicable rules and regulations of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board with respect to the liquor license in question.


