LEAGUE FEE IS \$1.00 PER PERSON (PAYABLE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SEASON) AND MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE RESIDENCY ROSTER THAT INDICATES HOW MANY PARTICIPANTS ARE TOWN RESIDENTS VERSUS COUNTY RESIDENTS.

LEAGUE DEPOSIT IS \$100.00 PER LEAGUE, DUE PRIOR TO USE, AND IS FULLY REFUNDABLE. A DEPOSIT RETURN CHECK LIST WILL BE PROVIDED, WITH DEPOSIT BEING RETURNED UPON FINAL INSPECTION. ADDITIONAL DEPOSITS MAY BE REQUIRED IF DEPOSIT IS EXHAUSTED BEFORE THE END OF THE SEASON.

NON LEAGUE USE FEES FOLLOWS THE AMERICAN LEGION PARK SCHEDULE. CONTACT TOWN HALL FOR FEE SCHEDULE.

PARK REGULATIONS

(Upon Signing this permit, the applicant/person responsible agrees to the following conditions)

- 1. The Town of Pinedale will accept reservations for Dudley Key Fields upon payment of deposit and use fee. Reservations are only accepted during office hours and are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. Reservations for ball fields are accepted at Town Hall from 8 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday. Ball field deposit and fees are due at the time of reservation. Reservations are on a first come first served basis. Reservations must include a certificate of liability insurance, naming the Town of Pinedale as an additional insured
3. Hours of use are restricted, in that all activity must be completed by 10:00 p.m.
4. No horses or large animals are permitted on the fields. No dogs are allowed on the fields.
5. Any damage to turf areas, sprinklers, structures or general mis-use of the fields or failure to clean-up the assigned area, is the responsibility of and will be charged to the person in charge and/or reservation deposit retained by the Town of Pinedale to pay for repair/clean-up.
6. No overnight camping is allowed at the Dudley Key Fields, unless authorized by Town Council.
7. The permittee shall be bound by all field rules and regulations and all applicable ordinances.
8. The person(s) to whom a permit is issued shall be liable for any loss, damage or injury sustained by any person, by reason of the negligence of the persons(s) to whom the permit has been issued.
10. The Town shall have the authority to revoke a permit upon finding a violation of any rule, ordinance or standard. The Sheriff's Department representative shall have the authority to revoke a permit upon finding of a violation of any Town Ordinance.
11. No commercial use is allowed.
