The meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by President Tom Weikel at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

The Treasurers Report and Sewer & Solid Waste Collection Report for January 2015 were presented and accepted upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. The motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Manager Leonard reported to Council that the Multimodal Transportation Fund Grant is available again this year with a match of 30%, and the deadline for the grant is July 31, 2015. Council asked Manager Leonard to see if there is a project that will fit the grant.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$127,864.02 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

WASTE WATER COMMITTEE:

The report of the Waste Water Treatment Plant Superintendent for the month of January 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion of P. Chrisman seconded by A. Metricarti. Motion passed unanimously.

P Chrisman advised Council that the generator has been repaired and the loaner has been returned.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of January 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion of M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

The report of the Code Enforcement Officer for the month of January 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

The report of the Chief of Police for the month of January 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

M. Bullick informed Council that the Police Department purchased a speed sign.

The report of the Borough Fire Marshal for the month of January 2015 was presented and accepted upon motion by M. Bullick seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

A. Dham thanked the Police Department for the great job in catching the bank robber that robbed the National Penn Bank in the borough.

PERSONNEL COMMITTEE:

A. Dham requested a short executive session regarding personnel.

Council went into Executive Session at 7:39 PM, and came out of Executive Session at 7:44 PM.

A. Dham made a motion to extend the probationary period three months (June 1, 2015) for Andrew Peterson of the sewer plant seconded by J. Kring. Motion passed unanimously.
