The regular meeting of the Royersford Borough Council was called to order at 7:15 p.m. by T. Weikel at Royersford Borough Hall, 300 Main Street, Royersford, Pa.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was followed by roll call.

Present: M. Bullick, P. Chrisman, A. Dham, J. Kring, A. Metricarti, M. Stehman, and T. Weikel

Also Present: Mayor J. Guest, Solicitor Brant, and Manager M. Leonard

The minutes of the May 12 & May 26, 2015 meetings were approved as distributed upon motion of A. Dham seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT:

Council had a discussion regarding smoking in the park. It was suggested that it should include no smoking in any borough facilities. Council asked the solicitor to draw up a no smoking ordinance.

Sacred Heart Church wanted to set off fireworks at the Fernwood Cemetery for their carnival. Council stated that the cemetery was in Limerick Township not the Borough.

Manager Leonard asked Council if they would make a motion to have Community Day on Main Street on September 12, 2015 7AM to 3PM. The motion was made by A. Dham seconded by M. Stehman. The motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard asked Council if they would make a motion to have the Halloween parade on October 26, 2015 at 7 PM rain date October 28, 2015. Motion by A. Dham seconded by A. Metricarti. The motion passed unanimously.

Manager Leonard presented a quote to Council from MJW Plumbing to convert the heating system from oil to gas in the amount of \$5,650.00. Motion to accept the bid by A. Dham seconded by M. Stehman. Motion passed unanimously.

FINANCE COMMITTEE:

Disbursements in the amount of \$217,939.69 were presented and authorized paid upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. Motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE:

The report of the Director of Public Works for the month of April 2015 was presented and accepted upon a motion by M. Stehman seconded by M. Bullick. The motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE:

M. Bullick reported that the Chief of Police purchased two solar speed signs from All Traffic Solutions as directed, and was able to save \$275.00 from the original price.

PLANNING COMMISSION:

The minutes of the June 1, 2015 Planning Commission meeting were presented and accepted upon motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. The motion passed unanimously.

There was a discussion with R. Brant, Borough Solicitor regarding the fire company's zoning issue for the new fire company building, it was determined that the fire company needs to go to zoning.

ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting was adjourned at 7:38 PM upon a motion by J. Kring seconded by A. Dham. The motion passed unanimously.

Note: Council President Weikel called Council into executive session at 7:40 PM. Council came out of the executive session at 7:50PM, no decisions were made.
